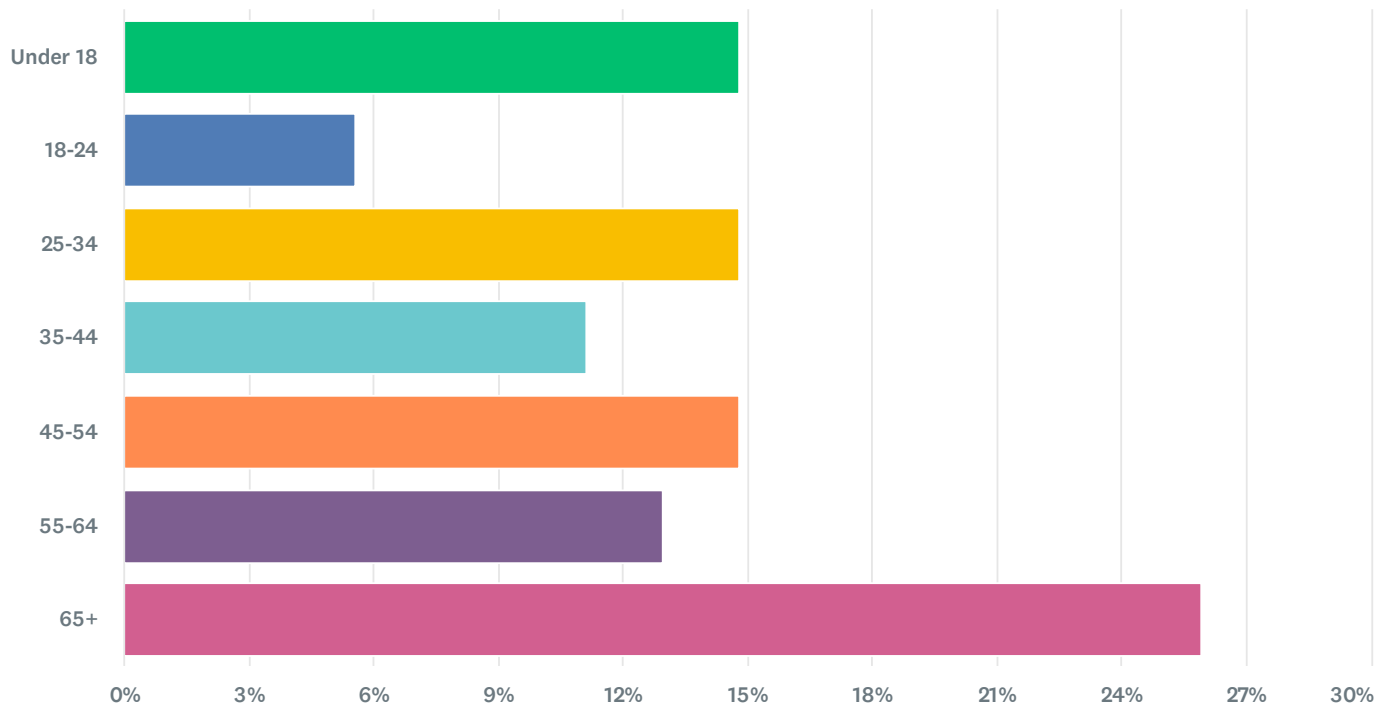


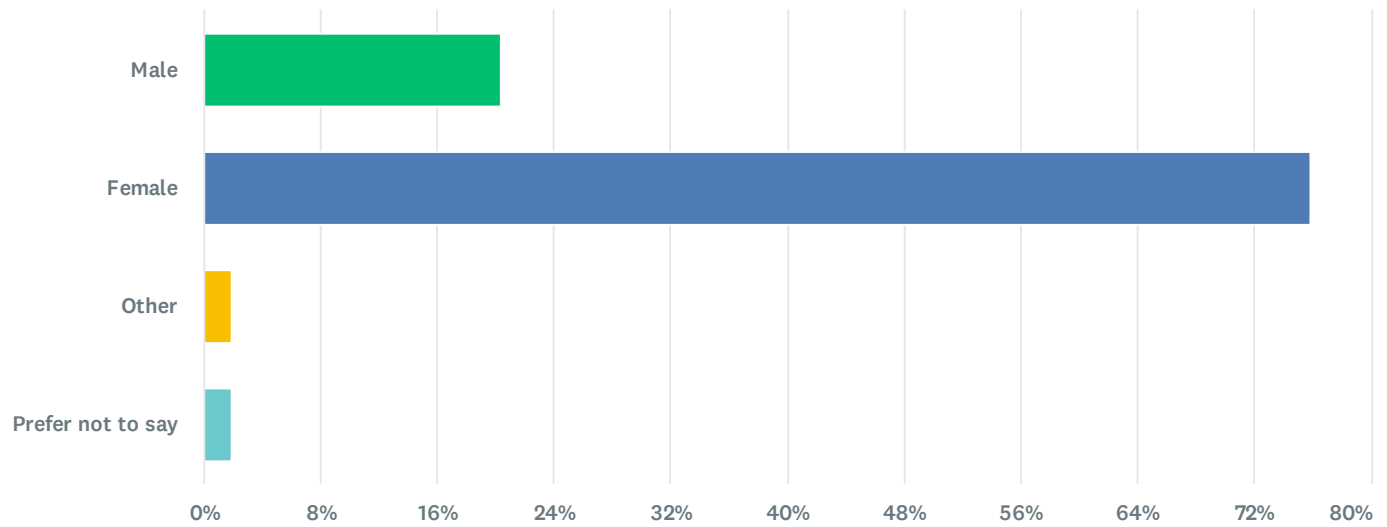

What is your age range?



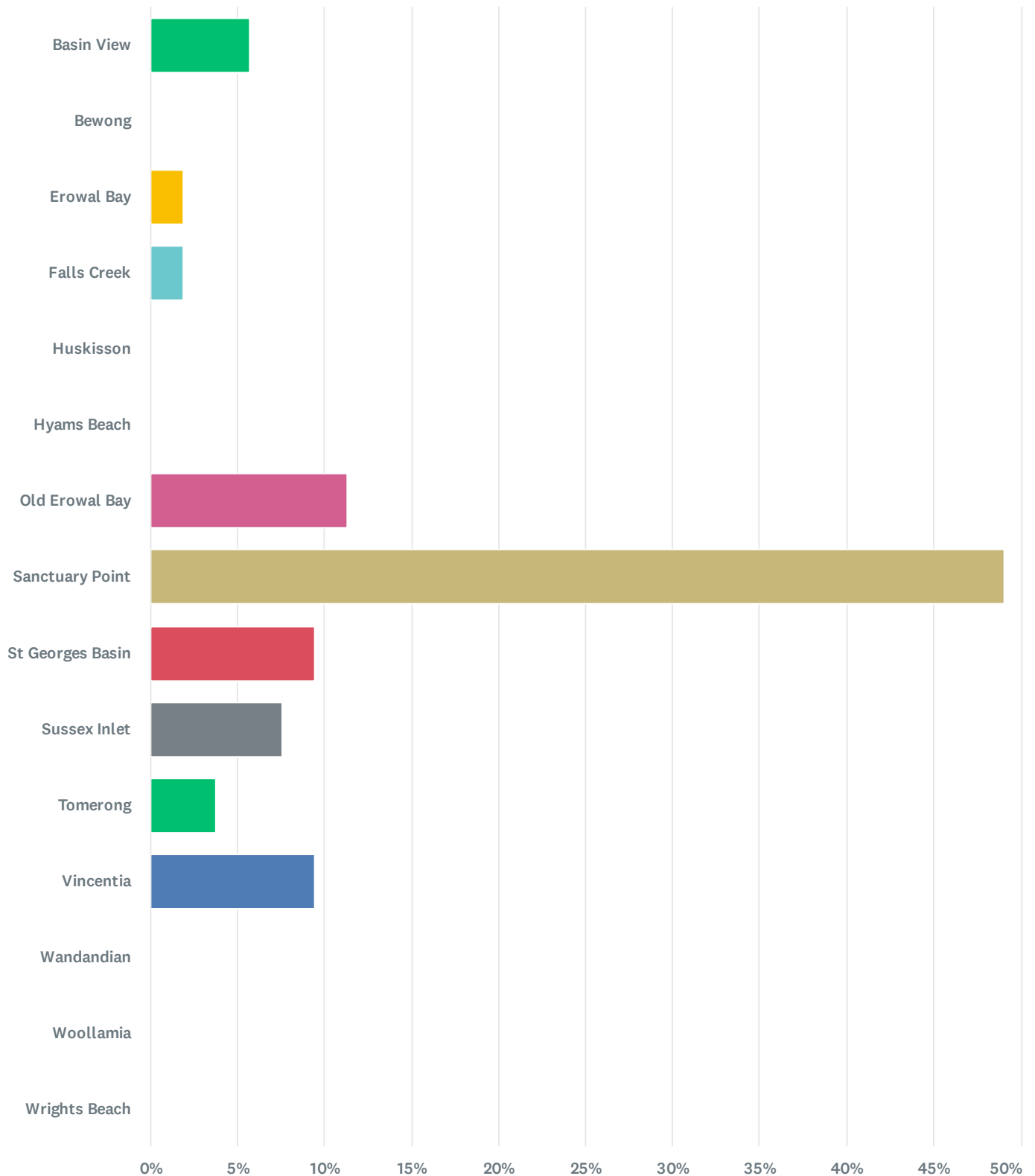

What suburb do you live in?



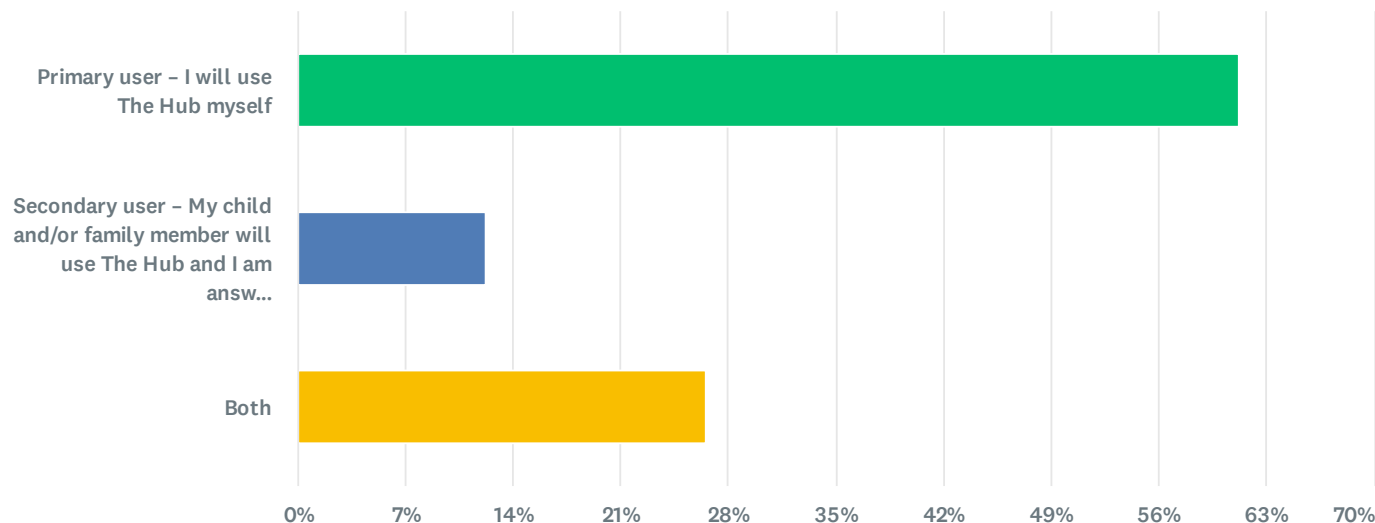

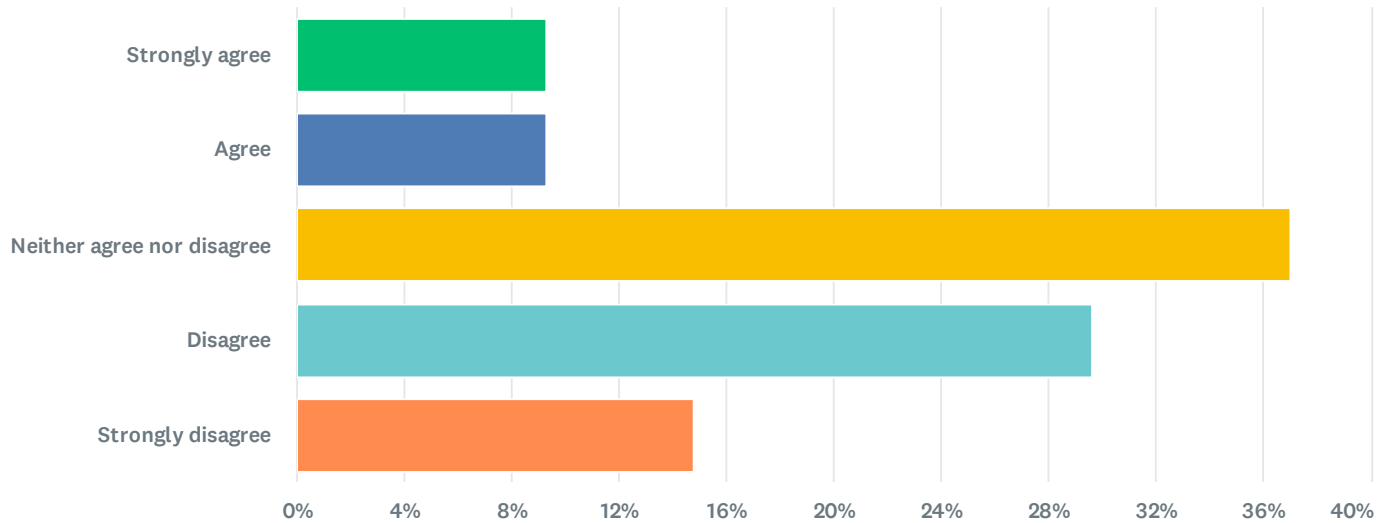

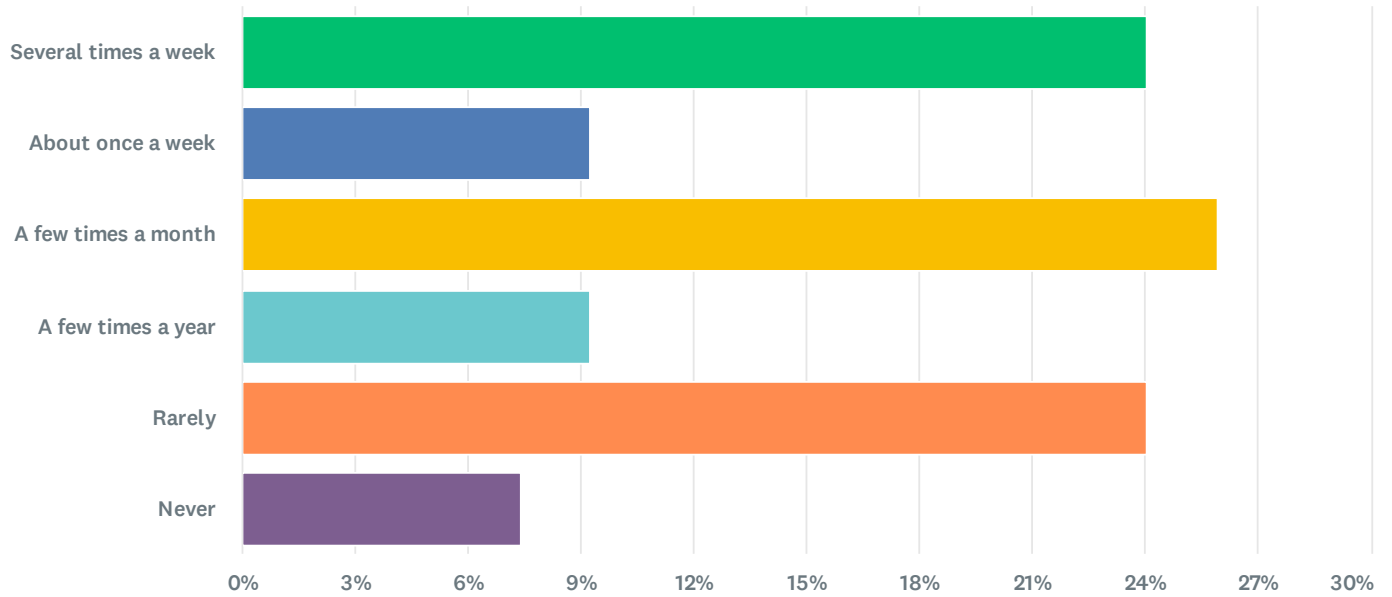

How much do you agree or disagree with the following statement: "Local sporting and community facilities currently meet my needs"



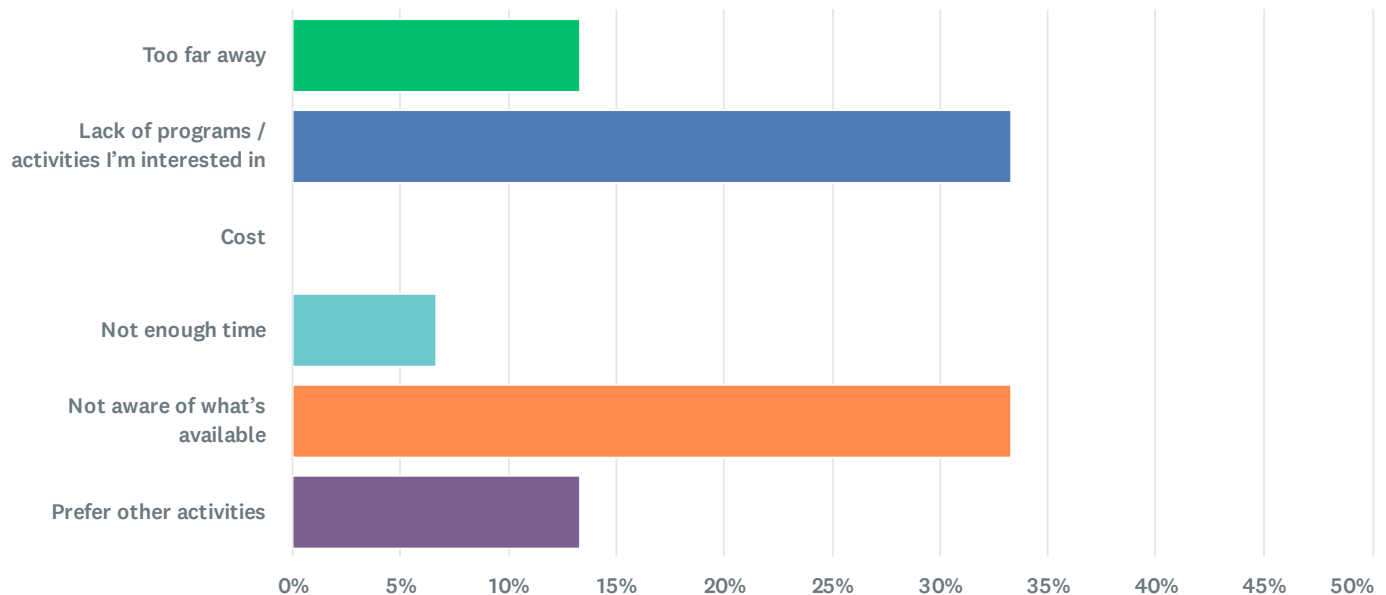

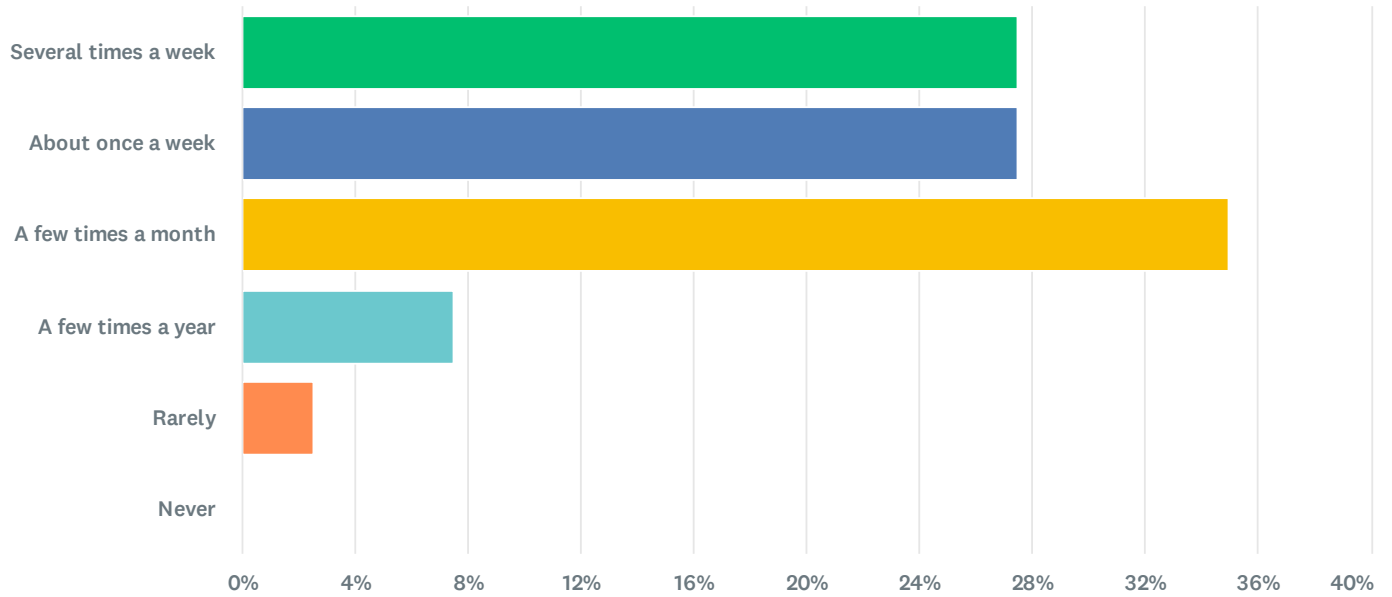

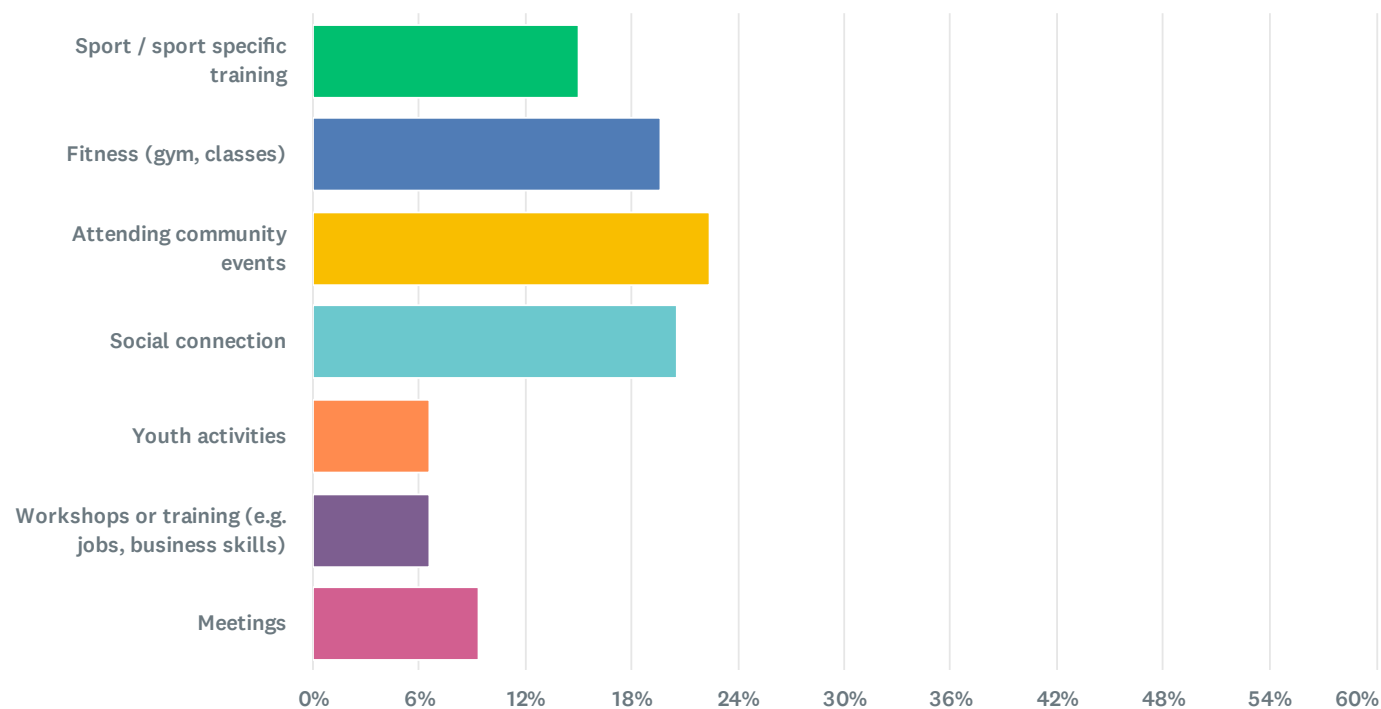

What would you mainly use The Hub for? (select up to 3)

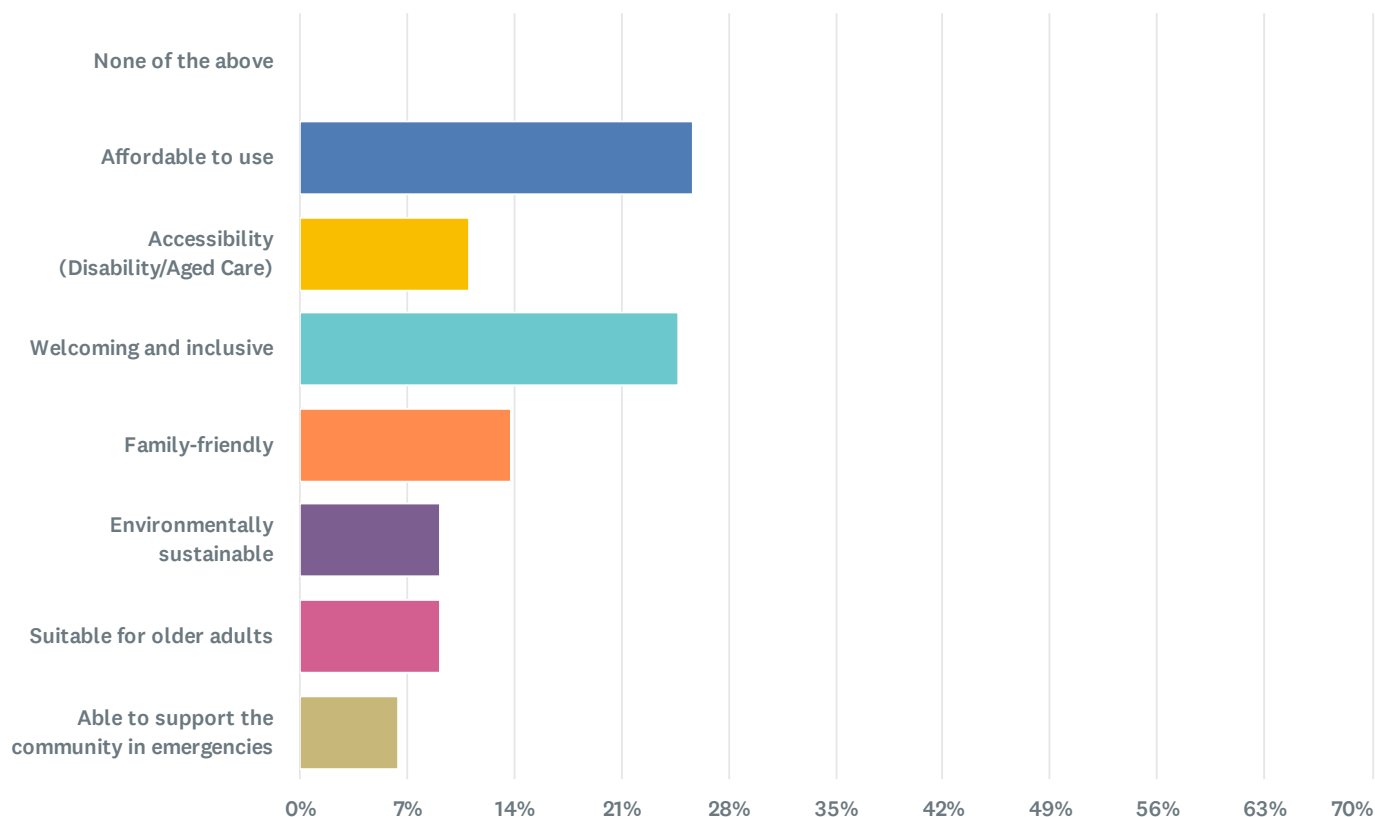

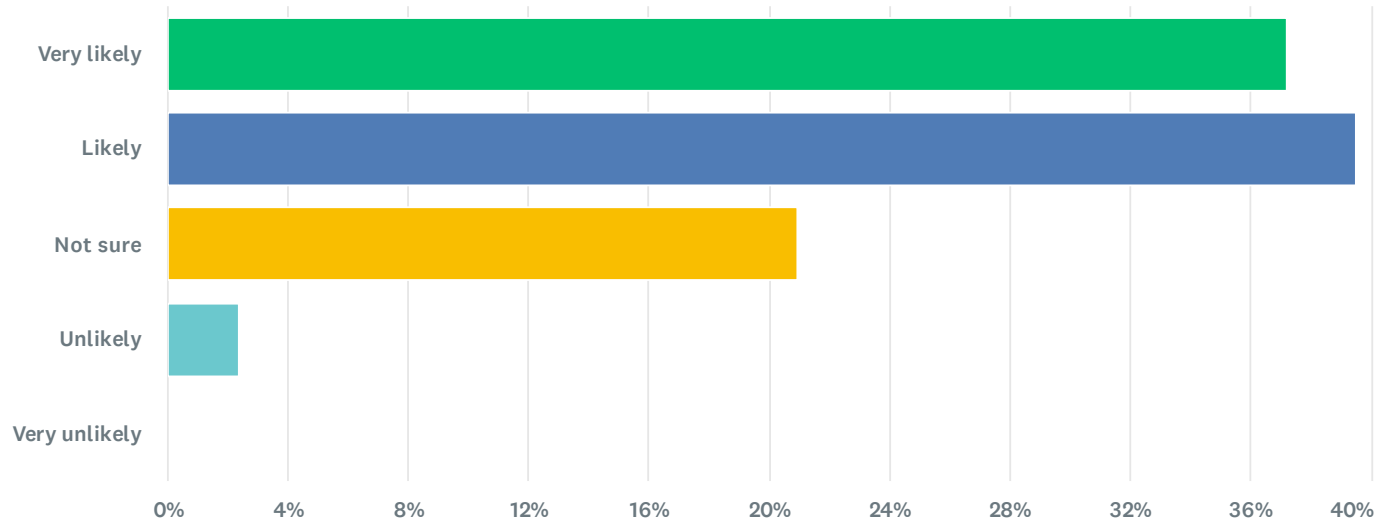

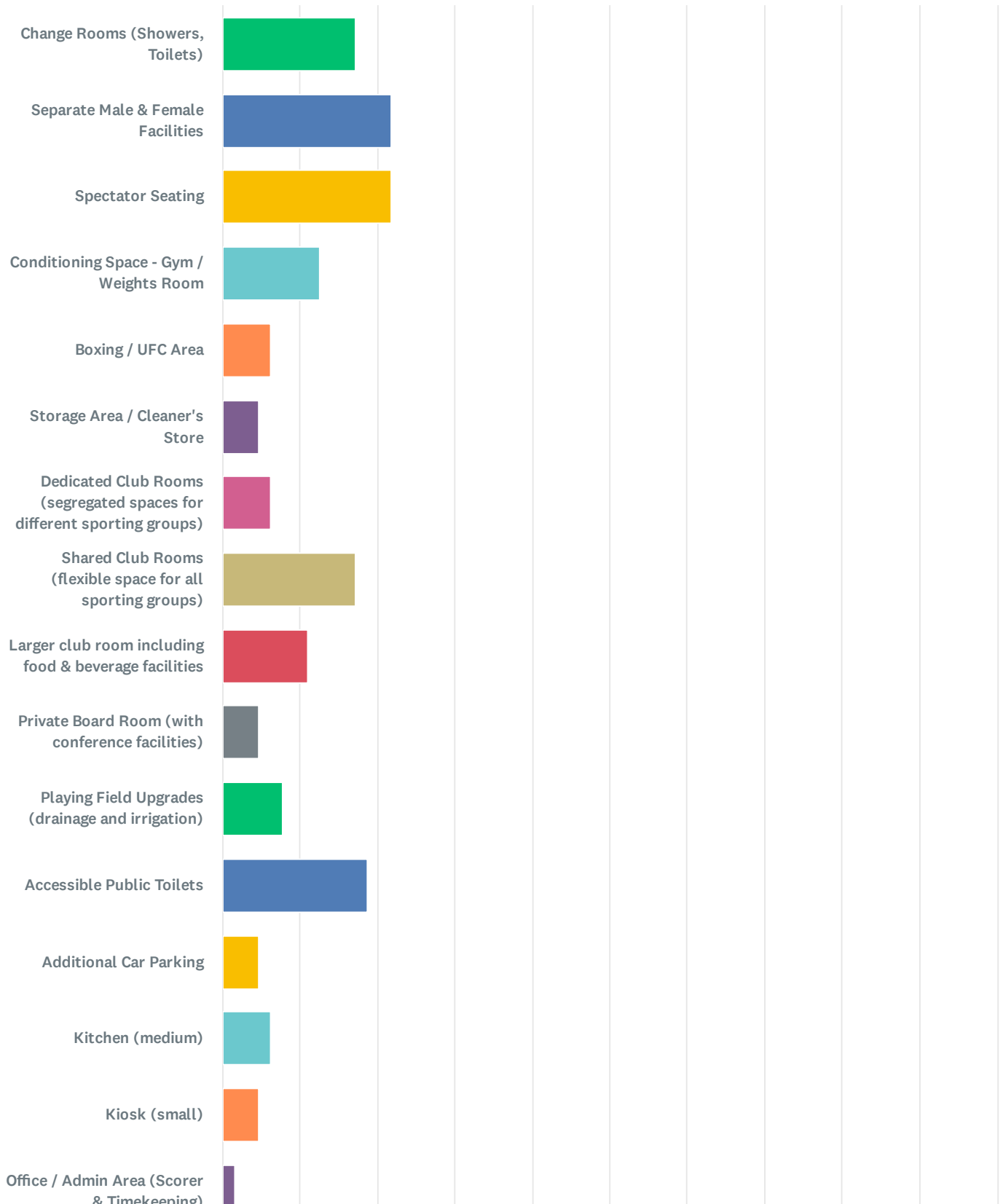

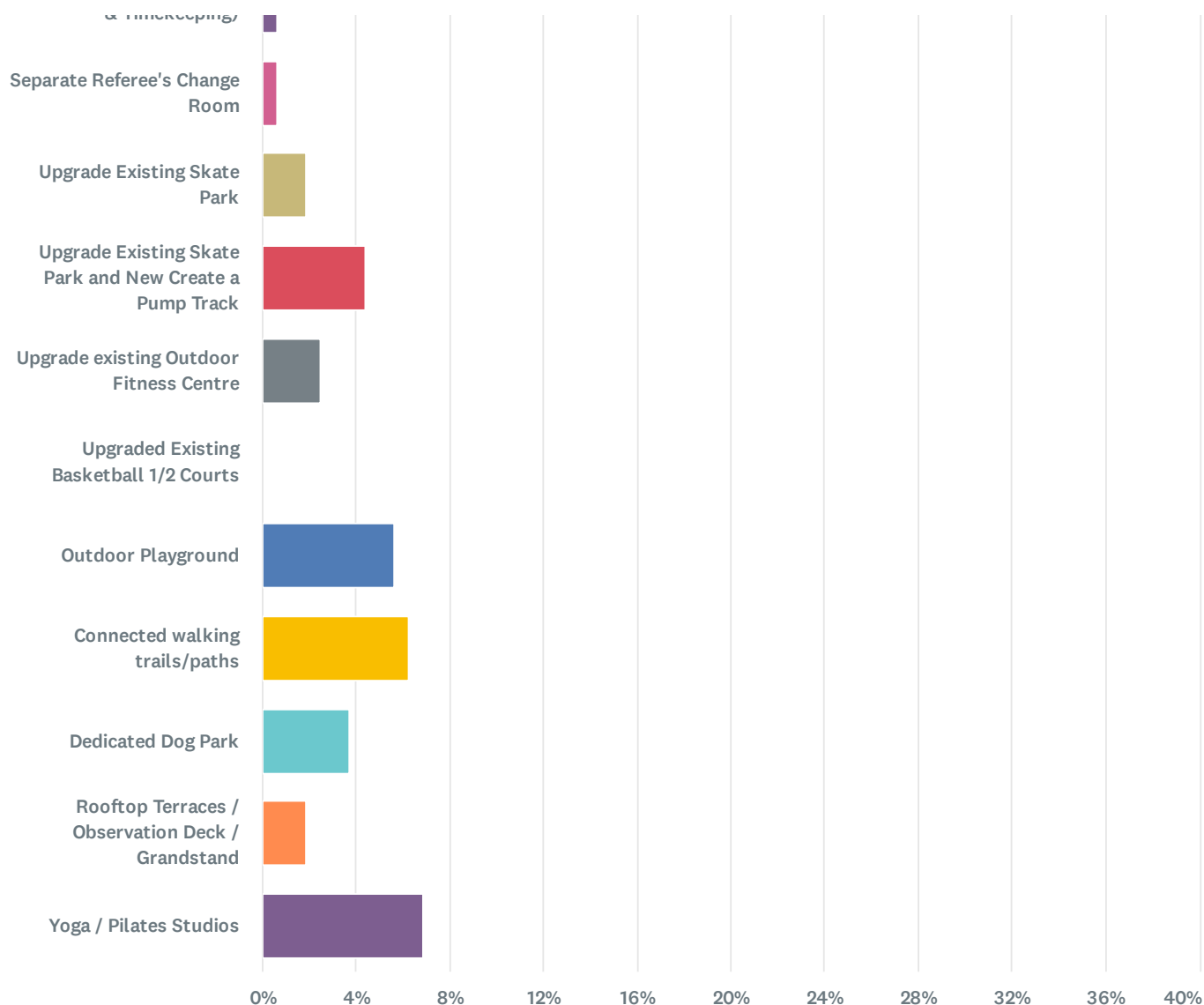
